A**Academic Advising Center (Casino x2360)**

The Academic Advising Center provides resources for students to identify career interests, determine educational goals compatible with those interests, and develop an academic strategy to achieve those goals. In addition to providing advisement, the center administers placement and credit-by-examination tests.

Academic Development Center (Library – lower level x2788)

The Academic Development Center provides free tutoring six days a week for all undergraduate GCU students. Support is provided by peer tutors recommended by the faculty. The center also provides workshops and testing.

Admissions (Lake House x 2700)

The Office of Admissions assists students in applying to GCU as an undergraduate, graduate, or transfer student. The office recruits prospective students and provides materials and information about the schools.

Archives (Library - Room 205 x2442)

The Archives Office maintains collections of specialized materials. Contents include:

- materials relating to George Jay Gould's family and estate
- original resources related to the history of GCU
- publications by alumni, faculty, and administrators of GCU
- materials relating to GCU and its students, alumni, faculty, and administrators
- materials relating to Mother Catherine McAuley, the Sisters of Mercy, and the colleges and universities founded and sponsored by the Sisters of Mercy

Art, Fine Arts & Graphic Design (Arts & Science Center x2388)

Degrees: Undergraduate BA & BFA in Art. The Art Department provides programs for students pursuing careers in art as well as students who plan to teach in elementary school, major in art history, concentrate on art and design, or become certified to teach art K-12.

Assessment and Institutional Research (Hamilton Hall x2237)

The Office of Assessment and Institutional Research compiles statistics pertaining to *Students* (enrollment, expenses, aid, and retention), *Programs* (academics and athletics), and *Resources* (personnel, finances, and facilities).

Associate Provost – Academic Program Development (Arts & Science Center x2373)

The Associate Provost for Academic Program Development assists the Provost in developing and gaining approval for new programs, interuniversity relationships and articulation agreements. The Associate Provost also helps develop and implement academic policies, works with GCU students to gain approval for their study abroad experiences, and helps meet accreditation requirements.

Athletics & Recreation (Wellness Center x2683)

The Office of Athletics and Recreation offers intercollegiate competition in the following sports: basketball, cross-country, lacrosse, soccer, softball, tennis, track and field, and volleyball. They also offer intramural volleyball, flag football, tennis, and basketball. Noncompetitive activities include yoga, aerobics, karate, Pilates, and kickboxing.

Audio-Visual Services (Eighth Street House x2222)

Audio-Visual Services is a division of the Office of Information Technology. It is responsible for providing various kinds of presentation technology to instructors for classroom use. It also provides technology to special events, media production services, and works with the university in designing room presentation systems.

B**Biology (Arts & Science Center x2345)**

Degrees: Undergraduate BS & BA in Biology, Graduate MS in Biology. The Biology Department provides programs for students pursuing biology-based professions, such as medicine and dentistry; careers as professional scientists in biotechnology, pharmaceutical or environmental sciences; or careers as elementary or secondary school teachers.

Bookstore/College Shop (Wellness Center x2633)

The University Bookstore is maintained by Follett Higher Education Group. The Bookstore carries all required textbooks for the current semester as well as school supplies, GCU clothing, gifts, greeting cards, postage, sundries, bargain books, bestsellers, and gift cards.

C**Campus Ministry (Gatekeeper's Lodge x2691)**

The Office of Campus Ministry coordinates educational and social activities of a religious nature in an effort to foster the spiritual development of the campus community. Campus ministers are available for personal counseling and Eucharistic liturgies are celebrated throughout the week and on Sunday evenings.

Career Development (Casino x2602)

The Office of Career Development helps students identify and explore career opportunities and alternatives, and to formulate academic and career goals and objectives. Services include career counseling, exploration, resources, events, internships, workshops, on-line job postings, and alumni resource bank.

Chemistry & Biochemistry (Arts & Science Center x2339)

Degrees: Undergraduate BS & BA in Chemistry and BS in Biochemistry. The Chemistry and Biochemistry programs provide the opportunity for students to appreciate chemical science as an intrinsic part of their liberal arts education.

Chief Financial Officer (851 Lakewood Avenue x2459)**Communication, Graphic Design, and Multimedia (Arts & Science Center x2362/2103)****Community Learning Center (Raymond Hall West x2716)**

The Community Learning Center is a specialty service of Georgian Court University's School of Education. The center offers personalized tutoring in reading, language arts, spelling, study skills, comprehension strategies, and math for children K-12.

Conferences & Special Events (Casino x2285)

The Office of Conferences & Special Events is responsible for developing a viable program of community and outreach offerings for both the GCU university community and the external community. The office markets Georgian Court facilities for use by outside renters. Conference Services also serves as the primary custodian of the university's space scheduling program, and serves as a resource for all university offices in planning and implementing their programs.

Counseling Center (Casino x2680)

The Counseling Center offers assistance and support in dealing with many challenges that go along with the college experience.

Court Café (Gavan Student Lounge x2443)

The Court Café is open M-Th from 8:30 am to 11:00 pm, and Friday from 8:30 am to 6:00pm. In addition, the Court Café is open for brunch and dinner on Saturday and Sunday from 10:00 am to 6:00 pm.

D**Dance (Wellness Center x2170)**

Degrees: Undergraduate BA in Dance. The GCU dance department provides two main programs for students pursuing a career in the dance field. Program graduates from the performance track will be prepared to perform with dance companies, theater groups, teach or pursue graduate study. Students enrolled in non-performance track will be developing their career in areas such as dance criticism, arts administration, dance therapy, or entrepreneurship combining the dance major with a second major or a minor such as Art, Music, Exercise Science, Communications, Psychology, or Business.

Dean of Students (Arts & Science Center x2315)

The Dean of Students assists the Provost in developing and delivery an integrated learning and educational experience for Georgian Court students.

Dining Services - Main Dining Hall (Raymond Hall x2728)

The Dining Hall is the main dining facility and is open M-F from 7:30 am to 7:00 pm during the fall and spring semesters. The Dining Hall offers an all-you-can-eat program. Full-time faculty and staff are eligible for the meal plan. Any member of the university community who does not have a meal plan is welcome to pay a modest fee for the same menu.

E**English (Arts & Science Center x2103)**

Degrees: Undergraduate BA in English. English majors develop skills to write and speak well, to read and interpret complex material, and to explain difficult concepts in comprehensible terms.

Enrollment (Lake House x2795)

Enrollment oversees Admissions, Financial Aid, and Registrar.

EOF - Education Opportunity Fund Program (Library – lower level x2355)

The EOF Program is a state-funded program that provides access to higher education and support for highly motivated students who exhibit the potential for success, who come from families/communities disadvantaged by low income. The program provides individual and group counseling in the form of personal, career, financial, and academic advisement.

Exercise Science & Wellness (Wellness Center x2460)

Degrees: Undergraduate BA in Exercise Science & Wellness. Exercise Science & Wellness majors are prepared to work in the health and fitness industry, evaluating health behaviors and risk factors, motivating others to develop healthy lifestyles, assessing fitness, and developing fitness and exercise programs.

F

Facilities (Garage x2652)

The Office of Facilities is responsible for providing recycling and custodial services, grounds operations, maintenance and repair services, event support, environmental services, pest control, mechanical maintenance, utilities plant operations, and automotive services.

Finance/Controller (851 Lakewood Ave x2218)

Finance is responsible for the recording and reporting of financial data for the University.

G

GCU Off-Sites (Woodbridge 732.791.2005)

The GCU Off-Site staff provides administrative support to the students and staff at all off-site locations. Responsibilities include facility maintenance and security, identification and recruitment of prospects, and the provision of all appropriate students services to students enrolled at the sites. The staff also serves as a bridge to the schools and departments in Lakewood.

H

Health Center (Casino x2756)

The Health Center is staffed with registered, professional nurses and a part-time physician. No appointment is necessary. Free, quality, confidential health care is provided to all Georgian Court students and the GCU community. Health education and disease prevention is promoted through health counseling, screenings, and wellness programs that are presented throughout the year.

Help Desk – IT (Eighth Street House x2222)

The User Services area provides general-access computing and communications facilities for students, faculty and the entire University community. The Help Desk answers questions and solves problems related to campus computers.

History, Geography, Political Science (Mercy Center x2376)

Degrees: Undergraduate BA in History. As global thinkers and students of diverse cultures, history majors bring much to the table in business, industry, and government. They have become business leaders, managers, bankers, archivists, museum curators, historic preservationists, tourism specialists, park rangers, intelligence analysts, political activists, lobbyists, Peace Corps workers, teachers, lawyers, and judges.

Holistic Health (Wellness Center x2663)

Degrees: Graduate MA in Holistic Health. The Holistic Health studies program offers focused study in the whole-person approach to health and the integration of spiritual, mental, and physical wellness.

Humanities (Arts & Science Center x2314)

Human Resources (851 Lakewood Ave x2215)

The Office of Human Resources serves employees and prospective employees. The department handles recruitment, benefits, compensation, staff relations, employee development, training, leaves of absence, and workers compensation.

I

Information Technology (Eighth Street House x2351)

Information Technology includes distance learning and online course management (ANGEL), faculty and staff development, classroom technology and audio visual services.

Institutional Advancement (Kingscote x2267)

The department of Institutional Advancement builds relationships, awareness of, and support for Georgian Court and its programs by communicating the mission and strategic directions of the university to all its constituencies, and by providing accessible avenues for their involvement in financial support, volunteerism, educational advocacy, and university relations with the civic community. The department serves as the chief fundraising division of the university by designing activities and processes related to all university fundraising from individuals and organizations. It also serves as the point of contact for alumni communications and engagement.

L**Library Services (x2419/2421)**

The Library provides a relaxing and attractive environment to research academic assignments; locate information for personal use; study; and use workstations/laptops. Library collections support the curriculum and include books and periodicals, current journal subscriptions, and audiovisual resources, maps, and microforms. There is also an online catalog system. A valid ID card is required for library use.

M**Mail Room (St. Joseph's Hall – lower level x2632)**

The Mail Room is responsible for the distribution of all incoming mail and intercampus mail and the posting and shipping of all outgoing mail and parcels. Special services, such as certified mail, priority mail, and express mail, are also provided.

Marketing (Kingscote x2256)

Marketing guides the strategic communications, marketing and advertising strategy, and brand management of the university. A key responsibility of the division is creating an effective and consistent identity for the university that reflects a differentiated position in the higher educational marketplace that can be communicated locally, statewide, and nationally. This division is responsible for creation, design and execution of all brand-managed communication across a variety of internal and external constituencies. Marketing is responsible for writing, designing, and production management of all university print material ranging from effective recruitment campaigns to advancement materials. Marketing also creates all advertising material for the university and negotiates all strategic media buys and schedules for print, radio, and television advertising.

Mathematics & Computer Science (Arts & Science Center x2499)

Degrees: Undergraduate BA in Math, Graduate MA in Math. The mathematics program provides students with fundamental training to attend graduate school, become teachers in elementary or secondary schools, or take advantage of employment opportunities in industry, business, and education.

Mission Integration (Mercedes Hall x2214)

Mission Integration oversees programs that help deepen our engagement and understanding in root traditions and values. Programs include, Mission Orientation and Work with Purpose.

Music (Music Center x2624)

Degrees: Undergraduate BA in Music. The music program encourages the development of performance skills for music and non-music majors through the study of applied music and participation in the string orchestra, jazz ensemble, concert band, and choral group.

N**Nursing Program - GCU/Meridian Health (Hamilton Hall x2183)**

Degrees: Undergraduate BS in Nursing. The State Board of Nursing has approved the Georgian Court - Meridian Health School of Nursing to provide a four-year Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.S.N.) program. This new full-time day program will help address the nursing shortage in New Jersey and nationally. Nursing students will rotate throughout acute care hospitals, skilled nursing facilities, home care, and hospice services.

Nursing Program - Seton Hall University (Music Center x2621)

Degrees: Accelerated BS in Nursing. Seton Hall University, College of Nursing and Georgian Court University have partnered with four South Jersey healthcare systems to offer Seton Hall's 14-month, 61-credit Accelerated Bachelor's Degree in Nursing on the campus of Georgian Court University. Applicants must possess a bachelor's degree in a field other than nursing and complete prerequisite science courses prior to starting the nursing program.

P**Payroll (851 Lakewood Ave x2110)**

The Payroll Office handles employee and student payroll. Including the processing of bi-weekly and monthly paychecks and maintaining all records pertaining to payroll issues.

Physical Education (Wellness Center x2684)

The physical education program is to provide lifetime activities that will further enhance the development of the total person physically, mentally, socially and emotionally. The primary focus of the program revolves around activities related to physical fitness, recreation, and stress reduction.

Physics (Arts & Science Center x2499)

Degrees: Undergraduate BS & BA in Physics. The Physics program fully prepares students to teach physical sciences, work in industry, or pursue graduate study in physics, astrophysics, geophysics, biophysics, or engineering. Students can also take advantage of summer research and fellowship opportunities.

President's Office (Kingscote x2252/2250)

The President is the Chief Executive Officer of the University and official adviser to the executive agent of the Board of Trustees and its Executive Committee. The President exercises general supervisory authority over all the affairs of the University.

Provost's Office (Arts & Science Center x2303/2314)

The Provost is the Chief Academic and Student Life Officer of the University. The Provost is responsible for the development and delivery of the academic and student programs and services in close collaboration with the faculty and student affairs staff.

Psychology (Farley Center x2636)

Degrees: Undergraduate BA in Psychology, Graduate MA in Clinical Mental Health Counseling and MA & CAGS in School Psychology. Psychology students learn valuable professional skills such as social and interpersonal skills, qualitative and quantitative analysis, critical thinking, problem solving, effective oral and written communication, and the importance of working as a team. Psychology majors find employment in mental health, business, government, education, health care, and social services.

Purchasing (851 Lakewood Ave x2219)

The Purchasing Office oversees the administration of the centralized purchasing services for all departments of the university. In providing these services in accordance with sound business practice, the office seeks to realize for the university the maximum value for every dollar expended.

R

Registrar (St. Joseph's Hall x2228)

The Office of the Registrar maintains academic records, prepares course schedules, conduct registration activities, evaluate transfer credits, audit requirements for graduation, diploma processing, transcript services, process name and address changes, process of enrollment verifications, assist in the preparation in updating the catalog and monitor academic policies of the University.

Religious Studies, Theology, and Philosophy (Arts & Science Center x2354)

Degrees: Undergraduate BA in Religious Studies, Graduate MA in Theology. The curriculum fosters intensive study in various areas of scripture and theology. Graduates are prepared for both ministerial and educational careers within the faith tradition.

Residence Life (St. Catherine's Hall x2533)

Residence Life is responsible for providing a safe, secure, well-maintained, and positive environment where students can learn, develop, and become independent as they prepare for life after their college career. Residence Life provides leadership opportunities to resident students through the Resident Assistant Program, as well as the Residence Hall Association. Residential facilities are available for full-time matriculating students in the Women's College.

S

Safety Officer (Arts & Science Center x2367)

The Safety Officer is responsible for the promotion of environmental concerns, awareness, and compliance with all government regulations relating to medical or hazardous waste or environmental impact at Georgian Court grounds.

School of Arts & Sciences (Arts & Science Center x2671)

Programs: Art, Biology, Chemistry & Biochemistry, Communication, Graphic Design, & Multimedia, Dance, English and Communications, Exercise Science & Wellness, History, Geography & Political Science, Holistic Health, Mathematics & Computer Science, Music, Nursing, Physical Education, Physics, Psychology, Religious Studies, Theology & Philosophy, Skills Development, Social Work & Gerontology, Sociology, Anthropology, & Criminal Justice, and World Languages & Cultures.

School of Business (Farley Center x2724)

Degrees: Undergraduate BS in Business Administration, BS in Accounting, BS in Tourism, Hospitality & Recreation Management, Graduate MBA. The School of Business offers a comprehensive curriculum to help students become creative and ethical leaders in today's globally competitive business environment. The School of Business offers a variety of academic programs at the bachelor's and master's levels through the Women's College, the coed University College, and the Woodbridge and Cumberland County College sites.

School of Education (Raymond Hall x2750)

Degrees: Undergraduate BA in Elementary Education, BA in Secondary Education, and BA in ESL. Students can earn teacher certification at the undergraduate level, post-baccalaureate, accelerated or graduate levels. A variety of graduate programs provide certification opportunities in administration, guidance and support services. All programs are state approved and are aligned with national performance standards, and off-site teacher certification programs are available. An important feature common to all programs is the opportunity for extensive field experiences in school settings.

Security (Casino x2616 Office/x2611 Front Gate)

The Security Department patrols the campus 24/7 by vehicle, bike, segway and foot. Officers are responsible for protection of persons and property, and responds to criminal, emergency, traffic and service calls. Officers monitor cameras from the gatehouse, greet members of the community at the entrances, help students, staff and visitors, and conduct crime prevention programming. The department is responsible for parking, student and staff ID's and card access. The department also maintains a lost and found section.

Service Learning (Casino x2713)

The Office of Service Learning assists civic community partners, faculty and students in creating appropriate service learning opportunities so that students are able to successfully complete the service learning component of the GCU graduation requirement in experiential learning.

SGA - Student Government Association (Gavan Student Lounge x2603)

The Student Government Association consists of all registered full-time Women's College students. This body of students elects its leaders, who officially represent the student body and are responsible for serving as the official voice of the Women's College.

Social Work & Gerontology (Arts & Science Center x2369)

Degrees: Undergraduate BSW in Social Work. The program provides students with specialized knowledge and skills to effectively practice generalist social work and be educated and encouraged to identify and affirm the ethics and values of the profession. This includes an appreciation for the value, dignity and individuality of all human beings and a conviction regarding the equality of all people, regardless of gender, race, creed, ethnicity, sexual orientation, age or disability. These values would also include a desire to promote social and economic justice with a will to translate these values into action.

Sociology, Anthropology, Criminal Justice & Women's Studies (Arts & Science Center x2336)

Degrees: Undergraduate BA in Sociology and BA in Criminal Justice. The basic objective of sociology and anthropology studies is to aid in the understanding of human life in all of its manifestations for those interested in a career in the social sciences. The major in criminal justice provides professional training in criminal justice with a strong liberal arts background for traditional students interested in the field and criminal justice professionals who wish to advance their education and enhance their expertise.

Student Financial Services (Mercy Center x2227)

Student Financial Services handles student account records, including the assessment of all registration-related charges, student payments, loan disbursements, financial aid funds disbursements, and student refunds. The office also provides students with information, applications, and confidential counseling related to federal, state, and GCU financial aid programs.

Student Success (Library – lower level x2363)

The Office of Student Success is responsible for First-Year Experience, the Transfer Seminar, and student retention efforts.

Student Support Services (Casino x2610)

Student Support Services is a federally funded TRIO program that provides a variety of services to help eligible students succeed in their courses and plan for their futures.

Switchboard (Mansion x0)

The Switchboard serves as a main contact for the university and provides information to callers.

T**TLC - The Learning Center (Library – lower level x2659)**

The Learning Center (TLC) is a program designed for learning-disabled students who desire a college education. The program assists individuals in becoming successful college students.

W**World Languages & Cultures (Mercedes Hall x2629)**

Degrees: Undergraduate BA in Spanish. The World Languages Department provides programs for students pursuing careers in the travel industry, journalism, communications, social services, government, international banking, import-export businesses, and education at all levels.
