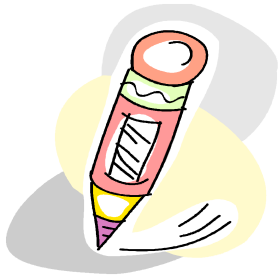


# Application Deadlines

## TRANSFER ADMISSIONS FAST FACTS

---

- ✓ Maximum of **90** credits from a regionally accredited institution. No more than **75** credits may transfer from a regionally accredited two-year institution.
- ✓ Grades of “C” or higher transfer in.
- ✓ CLEP (up to 30 credits) & DANTES passing scores are acceptable for transfer. For more details, refer to GCU catalog-pg. 32.
- ✓ ACCUPLACER test can be arranged for students who never took a college entrance exam.
- ✓ Receipt of a NJ AA or AS degree determines how an evaluation is completed.
- ✓ Military personnel and veterans may submit official evidence of service school for evaluation.
- ✓ Minimum of 120 credits are required for most GCU degrees. 50% of the major or minor must be completed at GCU as well.



## **TRANSFER STUDENT APPLICATION to ENROLLMENT PROCESS**

- ✓ Completely fill out and send (or bring in) your application for admission. Please include your \$40 application fee. Online applications are also available.
- ✓ Dance or Music Major-Auditions are required.
- ✓ PTK members – Send in copy of certificate.
- ✓ Arrange to have your official transcripts sent to the Admissions Office. Including your high school transcript if you have under 24 college credits.
- ✓ File your FAFSA.
- ✓ Wait to receive your acceptance status letter from Georgian Court.
- ✓ Send or call in your tuition deposit. Visa, MC or AMEX accepted.
- ✓ Upon receipt of your registration packet, make your academic advising appointment.
- ✓ After your advising appointment, register for your classes.



## GCU TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIP AND AWARD INFORMATION

- ✓ Transfer Scholarships and awards are granted to eligible full-time enrolling transfer students who qualify based upon their incoming cumulative grade point average.
- ✓ Phi Theta Kappa scholarships are available for qualified transfer students. Part-time PTK member students with an AA or AS degree immediately prior to enrolling may be eligible for a \$400 per credit tuition cost.

The University reserves the right to adjust the scholarship amount if the student receives additional financial aid from other sources.

**Full-Time (12-18 credits)                      \$ 13,088.00 per semester\***

**Part-Time (11 credits or less)                      \$ 570.00 per credit**

Residence & Board: 7 day meal plan: \$4,928 per semester.

5 day meal plan: \$4,833 per semester.
