CACC Notes

Bloomfield - Freshmen **Erin Mullins** has scored three goals in her first two games and leads the Deacons in shots on goal with 16. Sophomore **Missy Torzewski** became the first Deacon to be named CACC Player of the Week for Women's Soccer last week after scoring her second career hat trick and breaking the school record for goals in a career.

Chestnut Hill - Freshman **Lauren Riiff** added to her outstanding first week with an even better second week performance. Against Lincoln University, Riiff totaled five goals and two assists in a 12-point effort in the Griffins' 8-0 win. She scored the first three Griffin goals, added her fourth before half, and then converted a corner restart early in the second half. She also found **Julie Treen** for two goals in the affair. She followed that performance with an assist against St. Thomas Aquinas College (STAC). Riiff found Steinard at the far post 13:54 into the contest to give the Griffins a 1-0 advantage over the Spartans. Chestnut Hill went on to win 2-0. Steinard totaled five shots against Lincoln University, before scoring her first collegiate goal, a game-winner, against STAC.

Georgian Court - Three Lions scored two goals apiece in Thursday's 8-0 win over Bloomfield College to open the conference schedule (**Gina D'Ambrisi**, **Kelly Lyons**, **Caitlyn Schultheis**).

Holy Family - Holy Family went 1-1 last week to move its record to 1-3 overall in the early stages of the season. The Tigers picked up their first win of the year in the home opener against the University of New Haven, 4-3, on September 2. Freshman forward **Dawn Curry** scored her first two collegiate goals, the second one being the game-winner. Junior goalkeeper **Michelle Giambone** made five saves for her first career win. On Sunday, Holy Family was edged out by Queens (N.Y.), 3-2. Senior **Jamie Wallace** and sophomore **Kelsey Marvill** had the Tiger goals. This week, Holy Family is at Bridgeport on Thursday then returns home to host Caldwell in the CACC opener on Saturday.

Nyack - **Chauntel Veilleux** scored two goals and an assist in a 3-0 win over Mercy on Wednesday. She opened the scoring in 48th minute after receiving a lofted pass from **Kristen Naylor**. She added a second goal 14 minutes later on a pass from **Alisha Smith**. She later helped seal the victory by assisting on a goal by **Agnes Hitimana**.

Philadelphia - The Lady Rams went 0-2 in non-conference games this week, as they were held scoreless. Tremendous play from goalie Sara Hall kept Phila U. in the games. She compiled 30 saves on the week.
