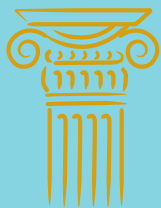

How To Apply

Please check the chart below for application, decision, and reply dates. The application, application fee, and all credentials must be received before the admission decision can be made.

Complete the application form and send it, together with a \$40 nonrefundable application fee or fee waiver request, to the Office of Admissions at Georgian Court University. All credentials become the property of Georgian Court and will not be returned.

First-Year Applicants Required

1. Complete the application form and enclose a \$40 nonrefundable check or money order payable to Georgian Court University, or send application fee waiver request.

2. Ask your school counselor to send an official high school transcript with 12th-grade courses and first marking period grades. Transcripts stamped "Issued to Student" will not be accepted.

OR

If you have completed a G.E.D., forward official results of that examination and your high school transcripts.

3. Submit two recommendations from your counselor and a teacher.

4. Ask the College Board or the American College Testing Program to forward your test results of all SATs or ACTs to the Office of Admissions. (Georgian Court's code numbers are as follows: SAT 2274/ACT 2562.) Test scores posted on official high school transcripts are acceptable.

Nursing Applicants

SAT/ACT scores are REQUIRED from applicants for the nursing major who have

graduated from high school in the past three years; SAT minimum scores of 500 for critical reading and 450 for mathematics for a total score of 1000 OR an ACT composite score of 21 are required for admission.

Optional

5. Submit a graded essay/term paper that you have written in the last year, or an essay written on one of the following topics:

- What idea, invention, discovery, or creation do you think has had the biggest impact on your life so far? Briefly explain.
- Describe your career goals and what influenced you to select that field.

6. Submit a list of extracurricular and personal activities you have participated in during the last few years, including school organizations, jobs, religious groups, community service, the arts, athletics, and individual interests.

Transfer Applicants

You must apply as a transfer student if you have attempted college-level courses prior to enrollment at Georgian Court University. (High school seniors with advanced placement and college credits should apply for first-year status. An evaluation of advanced standing status will be made.)

1. Complete the application form and enclose a \$40 nonrefundable check or money order payable to Georgian Court University, or send an application fee waiver request.

2. Request that an official transcript from each college attended be forwarded to the Office of Admissions. Transcripts stamped "Issued to Student" are not acceptable.

3. Applicants with fewer than 24 college-level credits must fulfill all requirements for admission to the freshman class.

4. The nursing major is a four-year, full-time day program for women and men. Transfer students must have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale and are admitted based on space availability.

International Applicants

International students are asked to complete this application form and enclose a non-

refundable check or money order in the amount of \$40 USD payable to Georgian Court University. On receipt of this application, additional forms and instructions will be forwarded to the international applicant. International students are responsible for all their expenses to attend the university.

Financial Aid

Applicants for state and federal financial aid must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). To complete the FAFSA online, go to www.fafsa.ed.gov.

To get the required PIN number, go to www.pin.ed.gov. The Georgian Court University code is 002608. Meeting the priority deadline of April 15 for fall enrollment or November 15 for spring enrollment will maximize your chances of receiving funds.

Academic Scholarships

All accepted full-time, first-year applicants will be automatically considered for academic scholarships. Scholarships for full-time transfer students are based upon the completion of college credits, cumulative grade point average, and admission to the Lakewood campus. Phi Theta Kappa members will be considered for scholarships as full-time or part-time students.

Major Programs

Available majors are listed on the back of this application. University College students interested in pursuing major programs not offered in the University College at Lakewood or major programs with fewer than 10 University College students (all majors other than accounting, business administration, education, English, history, and psychology) may cross-register for courses in those majors in the Women's College. The approval of a faculty advisor is required. Please note that many Women's College courses are only offered during the day. University College students must enroll in general education and elective courses offered in the evening and on weekends.

Applicants for financial aid and academic scholarship consideration are advised to submit the completed application by the dates below to ensure priority review.
